PROJECT HOMELESS CONNECT	Project Homeless Connect welcomes corporate organizations to participate in our large-scale service events as volunteer partners and sponsors. Holding five events annually, each event needs more than 700 volunteers and more than fifty percent of all volunteers attend through a partnering corporate group.
Group Volunteering Snapshot	A number of our volunteer opportunities allow volunteer groups to work together as a team. One such position is assisting in our Café, where participants are treated to lunch. In the midst of a sometimes fast-paced environment, our participants are invited to sit down, eat lunch, and enjoy the classical compositions from students at the San Francisco Conservatory of Music. Positions in the Café include waiting tables, bussing, packaging to-go lunches, and greeting guests.
	Each event has more than 20 volunteer areas to choose from, and we will work closely with you to figure out the best fit for your team. Contact Kit Solowy, our Volunteer Coordinator, for more information.
Our Impact	At each PHC event, an individual experiencing homelessness is able to receive assistance from more than 100 providers under the same roof. Because of this, what often takes months to accomplish can be completed in one day. From employment counselors to mental health professionals, lunch to a haircut, our goal is to ensure participants have all the tools necessary to improve their quality of life and to move forward. We hold 5 events annually and serve 2,000 participants at each event with the assistance of nearly 800 volunteers.
Exposure	As a partnering organization, you will be recognized at the morning volunteer rally which attracts hundreds of volunteers, local political figures, and a strong media presence.
