Project Homeless Connect excels in connecting San Franciscans experiencing homelessness with vital resources throughout the city. At our one-stop shop events and in our office every day, we link participants to dental and vision care, employment assistance, medical coverage and much more. By mobilizing city and community agencies, as well as thousands of volunteers, we ensure that participants receive holistic care in a dignified setting.

In early 2017, we will launch the PHC CareVan. This mobile service unit will bring PHC staff and supplies – clothing, eyeglasses, and dental care – to the communities where its resources are most needed. The CareVan will be the first of its kind in San Francisco, bringing collaborative, vital services to those who need it most.

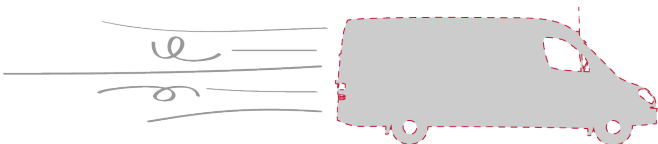
